The procedure for the visit is as follows:

A notice is sent home with the children prior to the visit which they fill out and bring to school with payment. JoAnn will pick up these forms in advance, sign and personalize the books, then bring them to school the day of the visit. Additional order forms are provided after the program, for those who may have missed the first opportunity. Any post-orders should be collected by the school within a week and sent to JoAnn by mail. She will sign these additional copies and deliver them to the school. If orders total \$300 or more, (typically easily achieved) the visit is completely **FREE**. If not, we ask that the school pay the balance – something that we've rarely had to do!
